

Name	Explanation
Phase	refers to the starter: 1, grower: 2 or finisher: 3 phase in the experiment
sanitary conditions	refers to the sanitary condition treatment, low sanitary conditions: 1, high sanitary conditions: 2
Batch	refers to the batch of pigs in the experiment, batch 1 or 2
pen	refers to the pen number (each pen contained 9 pigs)
diet	refers to the treatment diet that was fed ad libitum; high crude protein basal AA profile: A. high crude protein supplemented AA profile: B, low crude protein and basal AA profile: C, low crude protein and supplemental AA profile: D
eartagnr	refers to the eartagnr of the pig
tail damage score	refers to tail damage score; 1. no tail damage, 2. Bite marks; thin scratches. The individual bite marks have the size of a pinhead, 3. Small wound; clearly visible lesion with fresh or dried blood on the (top of the) tail, but the tail retains its entire length, 4. Medium wound; clearly visible lesion with fresh or dried blood on the tail and the tail is partly shortened, 5. Severe wound; lesion with fresh or dried blood, the tail is completely removed.
left ear damage score	refers to ear damage at left ear; 1. No ear damage, 2. Top or bottom lesions; thin scratches, 3. Top and bottom lesions; thin scratches, 4. Severe damage, part of ear is missing.
right ear damage score	refers to ear damage of right ear; 1. No ear damage, 2. Top or bottom lesions; thin scratches, 3. Top and bottom lesions; thin scratches, 4. Severe damage, part of ear is missing.
dietary CP level	refers to the dietary crude protein level, low crude protein level: 1, normal crude protein level: 2
dietary AA-profile	refers to the dietary amino acid profile, basal profile:1, supplemented profile:2
