

Requesting PReCARE data – Terms of use

The data contained within this repository do not encompass any information concerning individual participants. Should researchers express interest in utilizing outcome data, they are invited to submit a formal request adhering to the terms of use delineated below.

Requests for the reuse of data of the PReCARE project can be sent to Rita van den Berg-Emons (h.j.g.vandenberg@erasmusmc.nl). Applications must clearly describe:

1. Which outcomes are requested (intervention adherence, acceptance, certainty and guidance).
2. The purpose for which you want to reuse the data (research questions).
3. The methodology that will be used to answer the research questions.
4. How do you plan to collaborate with the PReCARE research group when using and analyzing the requested data, including proposed agreements on publication and authorship.

The PReCARE research group decides on approval for reuse. The following terms of use will be taken into account:

- Reuse of data is only possible when users comply with GDPR legislation and Erasmus MC policy.
- Before data is shared, agreements must be signed covering collaboration in using the data set, research methods, publications and authorships, etc.
- Data is **not** shared for commercial purposes.
- Data may only be used for research questions that are in line with the research and research questions described in the informed consent that was signed by participating patients.
- Data can only be shared of patients that gave specific permission for reuse of data by third parties (this was an item on the signed informed consent form).
- Only an **anonymized** dataset can be shared and therefore data cannot be linked to another data set (for reasons of privacy). The informed consents signed by participating patients do **not** allow sharing of privacy-sensitive information.
- The requested research should not hinder planned publications of the PReCARE research group.
- Reimbursements of costs is not necessary, unless the requested data sharing requires a lot of time of the PReCARE research group.
